

FRASER'S HILL Bird Watching & Nature Walk PAHANG

Fraser's Hill is perhaps the prettiest of all hill resorts in Malaysia. Nestling at 1,524 meters above sea level on the majestic Titiwangsa Range, it's about two hours drive from Kuala Lumpur.

This charming little hideaway with a population of about 1,000 is not unlike a quiet Scottish village. Granite mock-Tudor cottages sit a midst the brilliantly-colored blooms of an English-style garden. Most of these bungalows are private residences but some have been converted into holiday bungalows for visitors. They enable visitors to enjoy a country-style holiday in a cool, refreshing ambience, where evenings bring along swirling mists to descend upon the little hamlet while cold winds breeze though the lofty pine trees.

Fraser's Hill takes its name after a Scottish adventurer, Louis James Fraser who set up a tin ore trading station in the forested mountains on the Pahang - Selangor border. In later years, Bishop Ferguson-Davie mounted a search for Fraser but could not find him. Instead, the potential of hills as a cool getaway was discovered.

Life in the little hamlet of Fraser's Hill revolves around the market square dominated by a small clock tower, the most photographed object in this highland retreat. Picturesque colonial-style buildings have found new uses as the post office, police station, a clinic, a tourist information centre, cafes and restaurants. For the bird lovers, there is also a Bird Interpretive Centre at the sport complex. Though equipped with adequate visitor amenities, development at this resort hideaway has been careful to preserve the environment. Thus, visitors are assured of Fraser's Hills' original charms.

GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS

1) Reservation/Deposit/Full Payment

A non-refundable 30% of the package value deposit is required and payable upon confirmation to secure a confirmed booking:

Full payment must be made at least thirty (30) days before arrival date. If for whatever reason, we do not receive the balance on, or before the due date, we withhold the right to cancel your booking. Any deposits paid are non-refundable.

2) Bookings within thirty (30) days.

Bookings accepted within thirty (30) days subject to availability of package & accommodation. Full payment is required to secure this booking.

3) Accompanying Children.

Child price is based on child aged 6 and above but below 12 years old. 50% of the will be charged to child between 6-12 years old. There is no package for infants below 6 years.

4) Cancellation Charges/Refund.

Please notify us via email of the intention to cancel any booking at the earliest instance available.

After commencement of service, no refund, in part or full, will be given for services included in the package which have not been utilized. Where a guest fails to participate in pre-booked or packaged activities for any reason (including ill health) or free choice, they will still be charged for the package.

In the event of cancellation after full payment, the following will apply minus any bank charges, credit card charges and any exchange rate losses, if incurred:

a) From 29-16 days before arrival	30% of the trip's full price forfeited
b) From 14 days to arrival date	50% of the trip's full price forfeited
c) From 7 days to arrival date	75% of the trip's full price forfeited
d) "No show"	100% of the trip's full price forfeited
